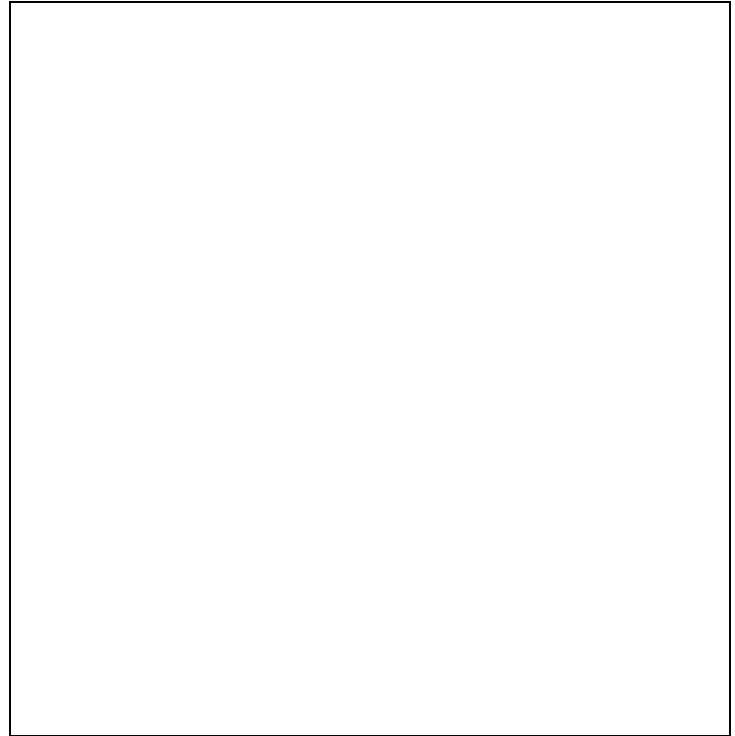

Offenses Against the Person

Reckless Homicide
Homicide

Offenses Against the Family

Domestic violence and injunction for protection (defined) means any assault, aggravated assault, battery, aggravated battery, sexual assault, sexual battery, stalking, aggravated stalking, kidnapping, false imprisonment, etc. of a family or household member
Carrying a child beyond the state lines with criminal intent to avoid producing a child at a custody hearing or delivering the child to the designated person
Incest
Child snatching
Exploitation for commercial or immoral purposes
Public Indecency lewd and lascivious behavior
Transportation for indecent purposes: Harboring, Prostitution
Pandering
Deriving support or maintenance from prostitution
Circulation of obscene publications and shows
Sale or exhibition to minors of indecent publications, pictures or articles
Child nudity in publication

Drug Offenses/Misc.

Any offense constituting a felony which is enumerated in state law of the Uniform Controlled Substance
Aggravated DUI/DWI
Felony Theft

Miscellaneous/Non-criminal Providing false, misleading or erroneous information on an application for a childcare position. Known member of criminal organization

Please Note:

Typically, when an applicant discloses the presence of a criminal record the hiring authority may consider date of arrest, severity of charge, circumstances surrounding the case and the position sought when deciding whether to grant clearance to someone with a history. Sealed, expunged records and records that are set aside are still required to be disclosed by most state statutes for an application to a licensed childcare or caregiver position.
